# Training on Supply Chain Management

An Introduction





The purpose of the course is to familiarize the participants with international concepts of Supply Chain Management in order to increase efficiencies and reduce supply chain cost. Reducing the cost of managing the supply chain increases profitability of the whole firm without the need to renegotiate with suppliers or increase the price paid by customers.

The participants will gain the following insights during the 2-day training course:

- -How your supply chain fits your specific company and corporate strategies.
- -How to design a supply network specific to their company's requirements.
- -How to find and select suppliers, what modes of transportation exist and how to choose the one that is the most advantageous for their company and situation.
- -The new INCO Terms 2020 will be explained so that the participants can confidently use them.
