MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

As another impactful year has closed, I reflect on the efforts we've undertaken together in 2023 to energize and bring community partners and businesses together. Through dedication and working in a challenging environment, the Chamber and its partners have achieved wins that make a profound contribution to the improvement of the business environment in Lao PDR. We did trainings on the subjects of ChatGPT, Bard and AI Powered Work - the New Competitive Advantage, and on LEGO® SERIOUS PLAY® - A Facilitated Method to Discover Ideas and Innovations to Expand your Business.

In 2023, our partnerships with the Lao government and the LNCCI continues to be one of our major points of focus, assisting in the areas that deeply impact economic development and advocating for smart business growth. ECCIL, represented by its President, Mr Peter Fogde, was the only foreign Chamber invited to deliver the keynote speech at the Lao Business Forum hosted by the Prime Minister of Lao PDR, advocating for our business community, ensuring the voice of European businesses is heard.

We also continued our close partnership with the European Union with the post-implementation period of the ICI+ SEBSEAM project, which allowed us to create 3 Advocacy Working Group in the sector of Hospitality, Trade and Logistics and Forestry Plantations and to do further outreach programs and events to support our member businesses, particularly in Luang Prabang.

Last but not least, we continued advancing ECCIL Green agenda, on climate change and resource protections, as well as workforce well-being, by co-organizing the Lao Responsible Business Awards, and the EuroCham ball to raise fund for the Empowering Women in Business program that will run in 2024.

LAOS – EUROPE ITINERANT PERFORMING ARTS FESTIVAL

The very first Laos-Europe - Itinerant Performing Art Program took place in Vientiane from December 8th to 10th, 2023.

The Itinerant Performing Art Festival - Laos Europe, funded by the European Union in Lao PDR, jointly organized by the European Chamber of Commerce in Lao PDR, Beasts on the Moon - Les Bêtes sur la Lune, FMK International Dance Festival - ຟັງແມ່ຂອງ (managed by Fanglao dance company – Laos and Kham company – France), aims to bring together visiting European artists and local Lao companies, in discipline such as music, drama, puppetry and contemporary dance, and to collaborate.

Thiane Khamvongsa, in her triple function as executive director of the European chamber of Commerce and Industry, director of the Itinerant Performing Art Festival - Laos Europe and director of the Beasts on the Moon theater company, explained that "not only does the festival focus on cooperation between European and Lao companies, but more specifically encourages dialogue from a culture to another. This is the place to see European artists giving their takes on Lao classical tales or French musician incorporating a Lao khene musician to their band." She further added "The festival is meant to be a celebration of the richness and diversity of the creativity of local artists in Lao PDR, encompassing a variety of contemporary and traditional art forms, but also to drive the artistic creativity by inviting international artist to showcase their arts and collaborate on local stage. Indeed, this program presents itself as a multidisciplinary event that promotes participatory interaction."

In her welcoming speech, H.E Ina Marčiulionytė, Ambassador of European Union in Lao PDR stated that the EU is "honored to participate in the celebration of this Laos-Europe Itinerant Performing Arts Festival, where cultural heritage is displayed in a vibrant showcase of languages, arts and traditions, affirming the beauty of unity in diversity. The European Union believes that culture is a cornerstone, not only as an expression of heritage, but also as a dynamic force uniting Laos and Europe."

Another particularity of this festival is also that it is itinerant. This will give the public the opportunity to discover performances in several cultural place of the capital indoors and outdoors, namely at the German Embassy in Lao PDR (Germanyinlaos), INSTITUT FRANÇAIS and Fanglao BlackBox thus artists can expressing their visions through various formats and places. Besides the main program of the festival (i.e. the live performances), four workshops by Lao and visiting European artists had organized to create a favorable atmosphere for collaborative experimentation in the creative process and international cooperation in Arts.

H.E Annette Knobloch, German Ambassador to Lao PDR said that "the German embassy was proud to have hosted the opening of the Itinerant Performing Arts Festival. Cultural relations and education policy, which is the third pillar of German foreign policy, aims to enable access to culture and education across borders, thus create mutual understanding. This is exactly what the Laos-Europe Itinerant Performing Arts Festival is all about".

On the opening day at the German Embassy, the program included an introduction to the Lao beloved musical art form of Molam. Mrs Douangdeune Bounyavong presented some background about this musical style and introduced several abstracts from different style and provinces interpreted by the band Sieng Khaène Thène Fa. It was then followed by « Intrusion Chorégraphique » a hip-hop contemporary dance performance resulting from a collaboration of Fanglao (Lao PDR) & Kham company (France). The evening then ended with a live music concert from "Koumdao Trio" a collaboration of Jules Pardon

and Yohan Nyirumulinga, two French musicians and Lao Khene player Khaen Souvannasan, as a trio mixing musical-narrative creations of aesthetics from France and Laos as a wave of reverie and good humor sprinkled with guitar strings, piano chords, trumpets and Lao Khene.

The second day saw at the Institut Français, another collaboration of the European company Beasts on the Moon with Lao company Khao Niew Group theater for a giant puppet performance of the Hmong tale of Notong and Gaonor, or "the khene player" directed by Thiane Khamvongsa and To Insixiengmay with live music from Koumdao and

traditional Hmong Khene player, followed by the "Giant Puppets" a performance populated by Lao mythical creature by Khao Niew.

The Itinerant Performing Art Festival - Laos Europe acted as an opening to the 14th edition of FMK International Dance Festival - ຝັງແມ່ຂອງ, an already well known international contemporary dance festival. As such, contemporary dance is very present in the festival, and the third day took place at Fanglao Black box with 3 performances of contemporary dance titled "90-24" by Noutnapha Soydala (Lao PDR), "Dating Abuse" from Sumove (South Korea) and "PhuYing" by Fanglao (Lao PDR). The festival also organized 4 dance workshops with visiting International and European artists Jill Crovisier (Luxembourg), Olé khamchanla (France), Company Siga (South Korea) and Arco Renz (Germany/Belgium).

As both festivals join forces, for one week this December, the city of Vientiane had been populated by performances with innovative languages, enhancing the new derivations of contemporary performing art, without forgetting the traditional cultural baggage in a new concept of two festivals full of stimuli and suggestions.

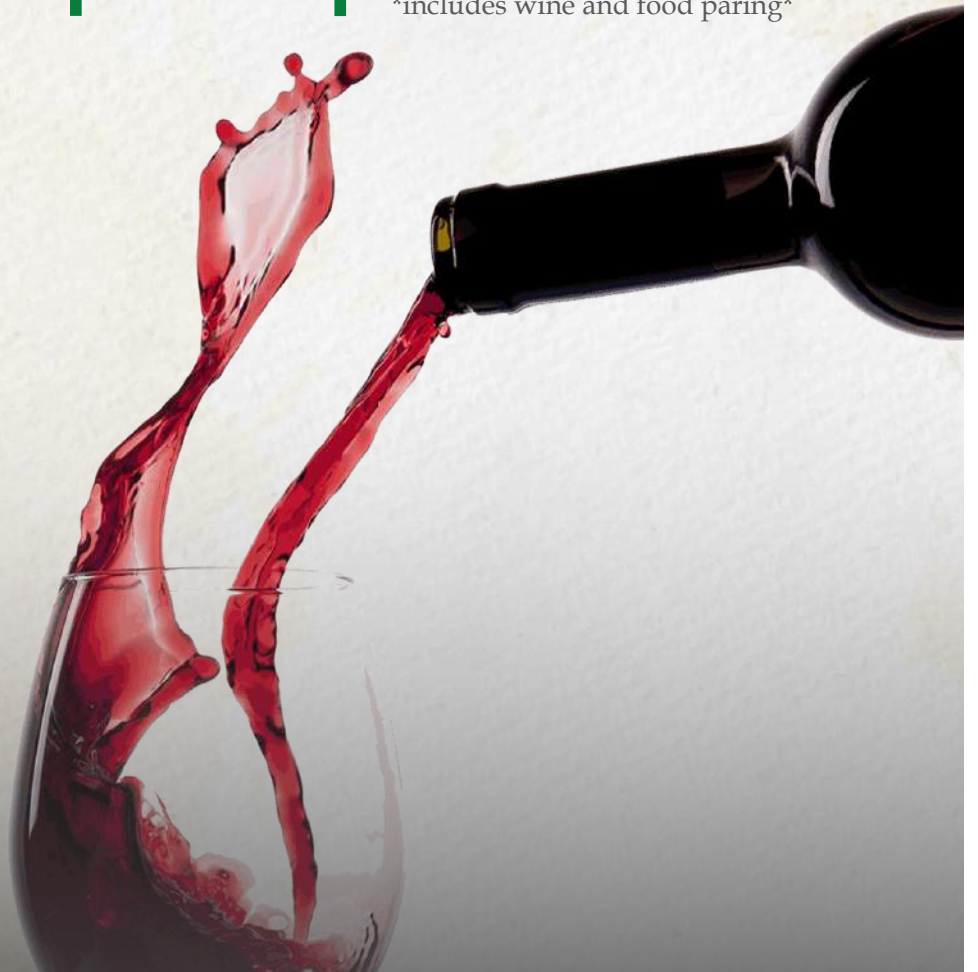
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Trade and Logistics Advocacy Working Group

On November 7, our Deputy Executive Director, Enrico Bargnani, and External Relations Officer, Phoutong Sorinxay, had the privilege of meeting with Mr. Bounyavath NIRAXAY, Deputy Director General at the Ministry of Public Works and Transport, along with his team. This meeting was a crucial component of EuroCham Laos' advocacy efforts within the Trade and Logistics Advocacy Working Group launched earlier this year.



Building on the success of previous positive engagements with executives from Thanaleng Dry Port and with a scheduled meeting with LITFA in the same week, the Chamber recognized the paramount importance of establishing a dialogue with the local government as a key stakeholder.

During this meeting, our Chamber conveyed its vision for Laos to evolve into an appealing logistic hub and presented specific recommendations for enhancing the business environment, based on insights from the private sector investors, members of EuroCham Laos.

The Ministry warmly welcomed EuroCham's involvement in the shared vision for Laos and encouraged direct feedback from our members. We seized the opportunity to discuss particular aspects related to Dry Ports and Thai-Lao border regulations, and we learned of potential positive changes upcoming.

We extend our gratitude to the Ministry for their willingness to engage with us, and we are committed to maintaining this active two-way channel of communication, which will allow us to relay feedback from our members and provide updates in return.



On November 8, Kenneth Jorgensen, GM at Scan Global Logistics and Chairman of the Trade and Logistics Advocacy Working Group at EuroCham Laos, along with Enrico Bargnani, Deputy Executive Director at EuroCham Laos, had the pleasure of meeting Mr. Sakhone Philangam, President of the Lao International Truckers And Freight Forwarders Association (LITFA)

This meeting marked the culmination of our first round of talks after the inaugural Advocacy Working Group meeting, focusing on import-export border operations, especially at the Thai-Lao border

Together, we've aligned with LITFA on the crucial need for clearer regulations and stronger enforcement nationwide, essential for Laos to establish itself as a strategic regional logistics hub.

Our discussion emphasized the balance between safeguarding local Lao companies and providing international sectors with options that ensure smooth supply chains, ultimately encouraging more investments in Lao PDR.

LITFA appreciates EuroCham Laos' feedback to enhance operational efficiencies and elevate service levels.

Notably, we learnt there is work underway addressing some of the concerns most dear to our members, voiced in the first meeting of the advocacy group, that would potentially facilitate international transport.

EuroCham Laos highly values the collaboration with LITFA and anticipates scheduling the next Trade and Logistics Advocacy Working Group meeting soon. This will update our members on discussions with Thanaleng Dry Port management, Ministry of Public Work and Transport, and our latest meeting with LITFA, to move forward our agenda and enhance the business environment.

This collaboration continues with training sessions and professional interventions across universities in Paksé, Vientiane, Savannakhet, and Luang Prabang until March 2024.





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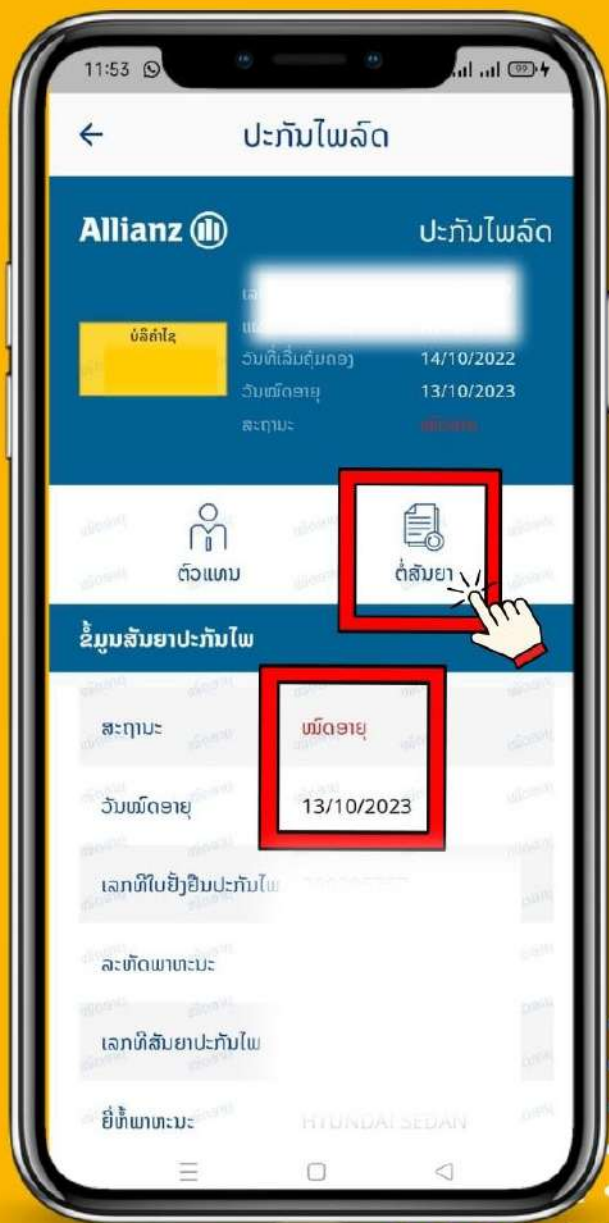
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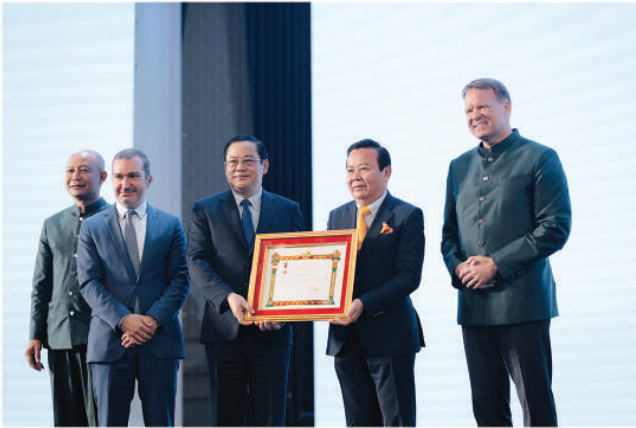
